

- Received 44 digital requests




## MISSED APPOINTMENTS

- 29 February 2024




We have recently said goodbye to a few staff members and are in the process of recruiting new starters. We really appreciate your patience as we train them in our practice processes.



# SELF-CARE THIS WINTER

Many minor illnesses can be treated using over the counter medicines. Please speak to your pharmacist in the first instance as they can often make appropriate recommendations.

Looking ahead to the winter months we expect that there will be a significant demand on our appointments. Our reception staff are trained to ask patients for the reason for calling in order to book you with the appropriate clinician who can help you. We cannot always accommodate requests to see specific clinicians, but we will where it is possible to do so.

Where appropriate we may also signpost patients to other services including local pharmacies and the Urgent Primary Care Centre.



## COVID VACCINATIONS

As Winter approaches the next round of **COVID vaccinations** for eligible patients are now available and we strongly recommend that individuals who receive an invitation take this opportunity to boost their immunity. Please note that most vaccinations this year will not take place in the practice but in Wrexham's local Vaccination Centre.

Eligible patients will also be offered the flu jab when they attend the local vaccination centres for their Covid boosters. If you do decide not to attend for your COVID vaccination but still wish to receive your Flu vaccination, then please still attend your appointment at the Vaccination Centre.
